About Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS)

Tata Institute of Social Sciences, a multi campus institution deemed to be University under Section 3 of the UGC ACT 1956, and a grant-in-aid Institute under Ministry of Education, Government of India, was established in the year 1936.

TISS occupies a unique position among the higher learning institutions in the country and stands out as an institution of excellence that continually responds to the changing social realities through the development and application of knowledge towards creating a people-centred, ecologically sustainable and just society that promotes and protects dignity, equality, social justice and human rights.

TISS offers various Undergraduate programmes in Social Work, Social Sciences, Analytics and Sustainability Studies, and Skill Education, besides Postgraduate programmes and Doctoral programmes.

School of Skill Education (SSE)

The School of Skill Education (SSE) was set up in 2011 to spearhead the Institute's commitment to provide skill education and training to millions of youth in India through appropriately designed industry relevant/market oriented skill educational programmes.

The core vision of the School is to create sustainable skill income sources for the youth by skilling them in key industrial job competencies through industry relevant educational programmes that would promote better employability, better livelihood, a brighter future and subsequently contribute to the economy of the nation.

Each of the Bachelor's degree programmes is a direct outcome of India's recognition of the importance of skilling the youth to meet the demand for 'skilled' workforce by the industries. All the programmes incorporate the skill sector's specific job roles and their corresponding National Occupational Standards (NOS).

The curriculum is an integration of general education and job-specific knowledge and skills which is transmitted through a blend of taught classes and practical skill training - a unique, distinctive skilling pedagogy brand of TISS SSE emphasizing on holistic education. The on-the-job training (OJT) is conducted at the real shop floor of the booming industries and companies of the skill sector. This practice based pedagogical process provide students the opportunity to 'work while they learn', directly in the workplaces of the industries and acquire the much needed work-oriented experiential learning and the standard job specific skills, simultaneously. Sometimes, students may receive a modest stipend during their on-the-job training/skill internship.

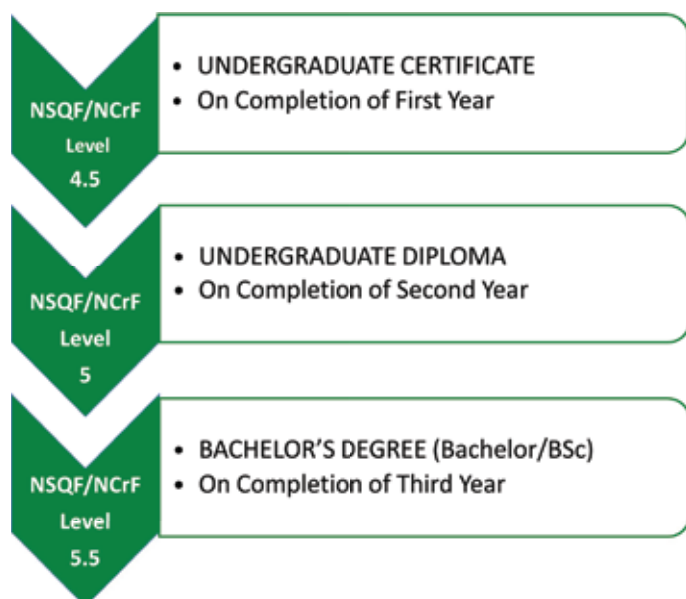
The one of a kind 'work integrated' skill training programmes offered by TISS SSE focusing on developing job-specific skills along with broad based education is being implemented for the first time in India.

Programmes Offered

The School of Skill Education, TISS offers various skill internship/apprenticeship embedded Bachelor, Post Graduate Diploma and Diploma programmes.

In the academic year 2025-26, the School offers 24 Bachelor Programmes, 3 Diploma Programmes, and 8 Post Graduate Diploma Programmes conforming to UGC guidelines. In addition to this, the School offers 3 Short-term Skill Enhancement Programmes (StSEP) in counselling, and health care, running during May-June and August-September. All the programmes are outcome-based education.

The academic-cum-skill progression and certification with multiple entry and multiple exit (ME–ME) pathways of the Bachelor's programmes is illustrated below:



Every individual year of the 3-year degree programmes is a stand-alone certification aligned with the National Skills Qualification Framework (NSQF, 2023) and National Credit Framework (NCrF, 2023) at levels 4.5 for the first year, 5 for the second year and 5.5 for the third year in line with National Education Policy (NEP 2020), all awarded by TISS SSE and recognized across national and international universities.

The students are job ready at every exit point. On completion of the programme opted for, a student has broadly 3 career trajectories to choose from, among others- to go for placement or employment, to become entrepreneurs by initiating their own start-ups or pursue higher education.

- b) SSC + 2 years of ITI

- Candidates appearing for their final HSC/equivalent examination can also apply provided they meet the eligibility criteria and upload all the necessary documents at the time of admission. The 10+2 or equivalent examination should have been conducted before the course commencement date.
- Admission to the programme is “provisional” till all the mandatory documents are submitted by the candidate and the same is verified and approved. If it is found that the candidate is not eligible at any stage after selection/admission /course commencement, the admission to the programme will be cancelled and fees will be refunded as per refund rule clauses.

The 1-year Diploma aligned with NSQF/NCrF level 5 and Post Graduate Diploma programmes aligned with NSQF/NCrF level 6 and level 6.5 aim to produce highly efficient professionals equipped with the necessary knowledge, skills and attitude to effectively deal with various pertinent problems faced in the work sphere. Each programme has different eligibility criteria.

The StSEPs are industry driven programmes developed by the domain experts to quickly equip students, professionals and practitioners with industry-demand knowledge and skills that address the immediate needs of diverse industries in the job market. 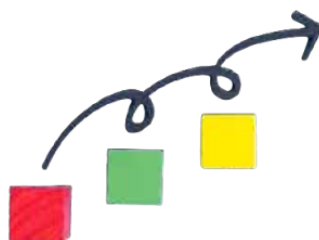

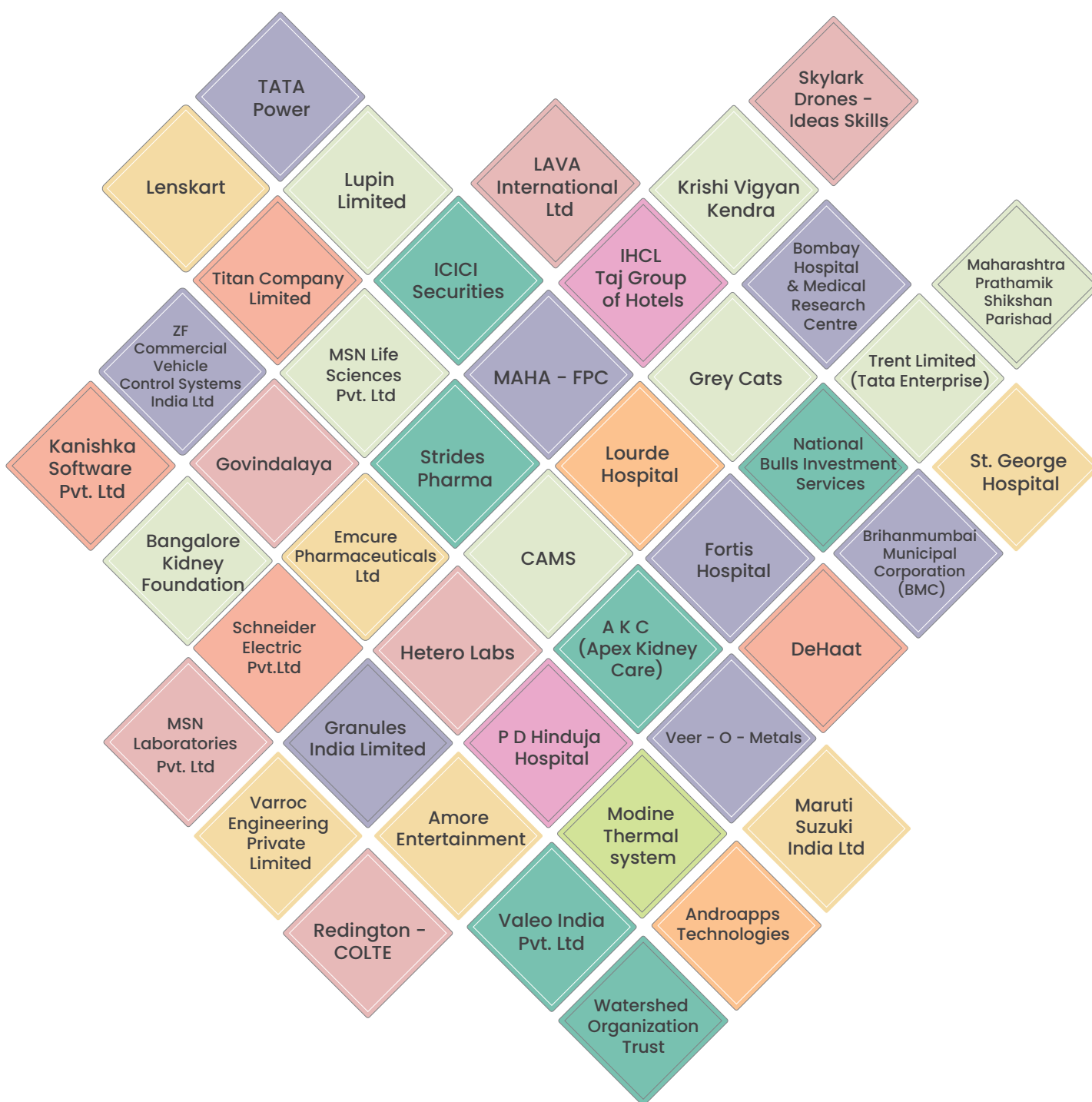
